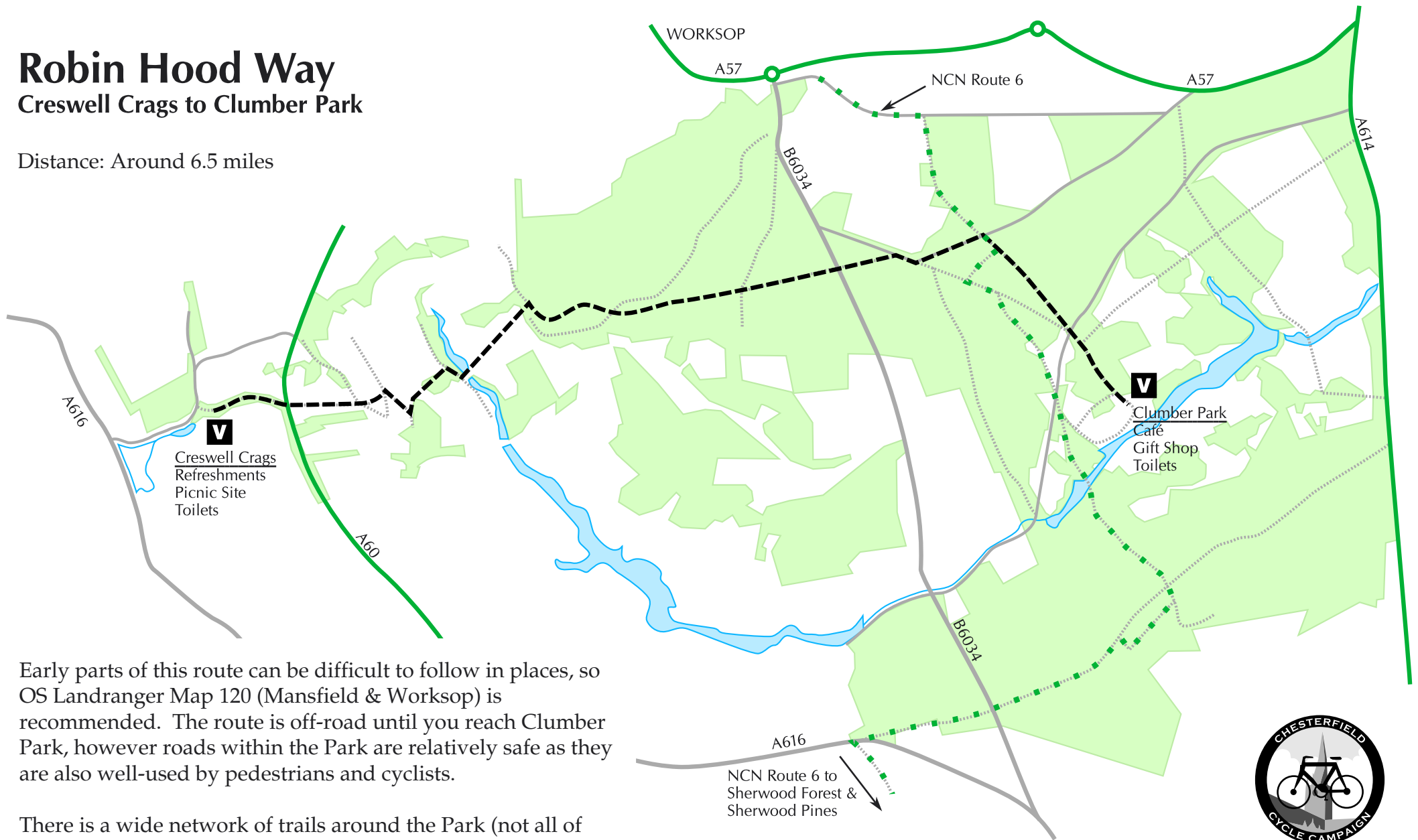


Robin Hood Way

Creswell Crags to Clumber Park

Distance: Around 6.5 miles



Early parts of this route can be difficult to follow in places, so OS Landranger Map 120 (Mansfield & Worksop) is recommended. The route is off-road until you reach Clumber Park, however roads within the Park are relatively safe as they are also well-used by pedestrians and cyclists.

There is a wide network of trails around the Park (not all of them are marked on this map) so the ride can be extended by a variable distance before returning to Creswell. **National Cycle Network Route 6** also passes through Clumber Park and, for a longer ride, the off-road route southwards towards Sherwood Forest and Sherwood Pines is highly recommended.
