TORY CYCLE PLANS SLAMMED

Tories attempting to slip dangerous Chatsworth Road cycle path proposal through

Local voters have been shocked to discover that the Tory county council has used the cover of the COVID crisis to slip through plans to cancel the longstanding Hipper Trail cycle route proposals in favour of narrowing Chatsworth Road from Holymoor Road all the way to Brookfield school.

Walton and West Labour Party candidate Steve Lismore is a big supporter of green technologies and getting people out of their cars and walking and cycling more. But he says, "To make lasting changes that have the support of the people, all people must be listened to.

"Many people have missed the consultation, which was very low-key to allow the Tory council to force through their plan. If elected I'll call for a fuller consultation and look to re-open talks with the landowners in order to ensure that green transport doesn't come at the cost of road safety,"
